




# Jomeone You Jhould Know DICK KUTCHEK

Richard ("Dick") Kutchek was born and raised in Chicago. He earned a Bachelor of Art degree in Architecture from the University of Illinois at Urbana. During his senior year, he created an incredible crucifix during a sculpture class. It was his first time welding and working with metal. The crucifix was recently on display at the Cedar Lake Community Art Exhibition.

After college, Dick married the love of his life Eleanor ("Dottie") F. Roll. They moved to Cedar Lake in the late 1960's. After working for 43 years as a project architect with the firm A. Epstein and Sons, Inc., Dick retired on his 65th birthday. Dottie worked in the Media Centers of Jane Ball and Lincoln schools for 32 years, until her death on December 1st, 2004.

Dick has lived in the same house in Cedar Lake for over 50 years. He remains active in the community and

at Holy Name. Over the years, his involvement at Holy Name included serving on Parish Council, the Finance Committee, the Remodeling Committee, the Garden Ministry, and being a lector. In the community, Dick is still delivering Meals on Wheels (the photo below shows him delivering to one of his clients, Joyce). He is also very active in the Cedar Lake Lions Club. 

Terrorism, mass shootings, gang activity, domestic abuse...one need only listen to the news each day and somewhere across our country and around the world, someone, or sometimes many, have become needless victims of violence. "When will it end?" people lament. "Enough is enough", they say. But what can we do? Pope Francis tells us, "Let us beg the Lord, God of mercy and peace, to free the world from this inhuman violence." He goes on to say that we must "turn to the way of peace and goodness, of respect for the life and dignity of every human being, regardless of religion, origin,

wealth or poverty." He asks all to pray for the victims of violence, their families and loved ones, and also for those who have committed these heinous crimes and those contemplating such violence.

The violence we continually hear about touches us all of us, and weighs heavily on our hearts and in our minds. It happens everywhere, and our own community in Cedar Lake is not exempt. As Christians, we need to heed the words of Pope Francis. On Sunday, October 13th, during this month dedicated to Mary and the Holy Rosary, we will gather for a Holy Hour at 3:00 p.m. Our intention during the recitation of the rosary on this day will be to "Stop the Violence." We invite parishioners of all ages to join us as we pray for a return to the way of peace and goodness.
