IMPORTANT CEMETERY INFORMATION

1. All decorations must be attached to the head stone.
2. Planting of shrubs and plants is prohibited.
3. Shepherd's hooks are prohibited.
4. Enclosures of any kind are not allowed, including fences, rocks, decorative curbing and landscape edging.
5. Statues, wind chimes, and loose objects are not allowed on the markers.
6. Grave blankets and wreaths are allowed as winter decorations and **must be removed by April 1st.**
7. Dogs, skateboards and bicycles are not allowed in cemetery.
8. Anyone damaging cemetery property will be arrested.
9. Holy Name Cemetery reserves the right to remove all objects that are not attached to the headstone and whose appearance and condition is unacceptable. Holy Name Cemetery will not be liable for any decorations that are removed.
10. **The annual cleanup of the cemetery begins April 1st.** Anything not attached to the headstone will be removed and discarded.



THE BOTTOM LINE...

Anything that is not attached to the headstone will be discarded when the lawn mowing season starts.

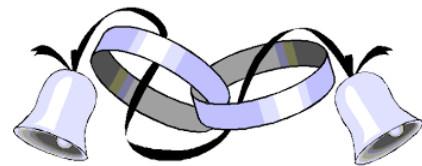

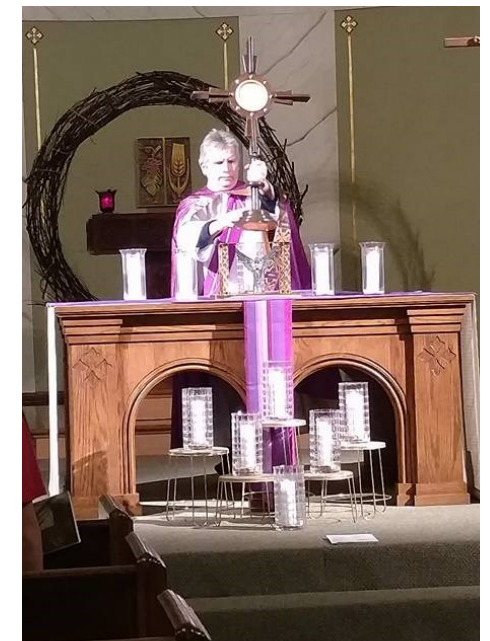
