


Dear Parishioners,

In the gospel reading for the Third Sunday of Easter, May 1, 2022, Jesus invites the disciples who were fishing and caught nothing, to "cast the net to the right side of the boat and you will find something." They did so and the net was filled with 153 large fish.

That weekend, I invited each member of the community gathered for Mass, to cast their net to the side of a positive attitude toward the Catholic Service Appeal and to participate in raising \$61,676 so that Holy Name of Jesus Parish may reach it assessed goal. Dear Parishioners of Holy Name of Jesus Catholic Church,

Thank you for your very generous gift of \$10,000.00 to the Franciscan Missions to provide emergency relief to the people of Ukraine and the refugees in Poland.

Fr. Romuald, parish priest of the Franciscan friary in Konotop, Ukraine, described the current conditions: "The streets of daily life have become a battlefield, civilian and military vehicles are set on fire, numerous victims are scattered throughout the city."

The Franciscans of the Province of the St. Michael the Archangel opened the doors of their friaries to women and children as soon as the bombing of their cities began. The friars are hosting refugees who are seeking food and protection in the basements of the friaries. In Poland, Fr. Teofil Czarniak, OFM, Minister Provincial of the Immaculate Conception of the BVM Province in Krakow, informed us that the friars have prepared accommodations for 500 refugees.

Your prayers and generous gift will keep hope alive in the hearts of the innocent who are experiencing the horror and tragedy of war. Thank you for opening your heart to our sisters and brothers in Jesus Christ our Lord. Let us pray to our Lady, the Queen of Peace, for a quick end to this war.


